

Useful Information Equipment List

The following list is a summary of the equipment that NARCH suggest that a hydrotherapy centre should have.

- First Aid Kit - Human & Canine (including eye wash)
- Accident Book
- Incident Book
- Stretcher or appropriate method of safely moving a dog that has collapsed
- Muzzles – a range of sizes
- Life jackets and harnesses – a range of sizes and NARCH standard (see Guide to Professional Conduct)
- Collars
- Spare Lead
- PPE Equipment including, respirator mask, gloves, splash goggles and aprons (for more information see the next page)
- Emergency Details Sign – clearly showing address/directions/phone numbers of emergency vets and any other emergency contact numbers, nearest hospital and directions, centre address and directions to the centre should someone need to give them over the phone to emergency services.
- Fire Safety Signs – evacuation meeting point, fire exits etc
